

# Auburn Security Report

Local security guide - Auburn NSW 2144 - Western Sydney, Cumberland City

## About Auburn

Auburn is about 17 km west of the Sydney CBD.

Auburn sits between Parramatta and Strathfield in the Cumberland council area, with Auburn Central, the Auburn Road shopping strip, a railway station and industrial and warehouse areas nearby. BOCSAR recorded 2,007 criminal incidents in Auburn in the year to June 2026 (not counting transport fines and breaches of bail or court orders), about the same as the 2,020 the year before. Intimidation, stalking and harassment (201), fraud (178) and non-domestic assault (177) were the largest groups, and there were 93 motor vehicle thefts.

## Housing and local context

**Housing stock: Apartment blocks near the station, federation and post-war houses, and industrial and warehouse buildings.**

Auburn mixes apartment blocks that have replaced older houses near the station with streets of federation and post-war homes, and it borders industrial and warehouse areas where many local people work. It is one of Sydney's most multicultural suburbs, with shops and restaurants along Auburn Road that trade into the evening. Apartment residents share basement car parks, while older houses often park on the street.

## Common security concerns in Auburn

- Car theft, including older cars without immobilisers
- Theft from cars parked on the street and in shared car parks
- Warehouses and workshops in nearby industrial areas after hours

## Local tip: Make the car harder to drive away

Auburn recorded 93 motor vehicle thefts last year. Older cars without immobilisers are the easiest to take, and some newer keyless cars can be stolen by relaying the key's signal from inside the house. Use a steering wheel lock on older cars, keep keyless fobs in a signal-blocking pouch or well away from the front door, and park in a locked garage or a well-lit spot covered by a camera.

**Before you hire: checklist**

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register ([abr.business.gov.au](http://abr.business.gov.au)).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
