

# Bellerive Security Report

Local security guide - Bellerive TAS 7018 - Greater Hobart, Clarence City Council

## About Bellerive

Bellerive is about 3 km east of the Hobart CBD across the Derwent.

Bellerive is on Hobart's eastern shore in the City of Clarence, with the Bellerive boardwalk and village, Bellerive Oval, the ferry to the city, and the Eastlands shopping centre and council offices at nearby Rosny Park. Tasmania Police recorded 3,434 offences in the Clarence police division, which covers the eastern shore suburbs, in 2025-26, down from 3,551 the year before. Property offences (2,699) made up most of the total, including 350 property damage offences, 147 stolen vehicles, 134 motor vehicle burglaries and 102 home burglaries, and there were 559 offences against the person.

## Housing and local context

**Housing stock: Older weatherboard and brick homes near the village, units, and brick family homes across the eastern shore suburbs.**

Bellerive's older streets near the village and the waterfront have weatherboard and brick homes and units, while suburbs across the eastern shore have brick family homes with garages. Many homes have water views and large windows facing the river, and sloping blocks can leave back doors and windows out of sight of the street. Crowds on event days at Bellerive Oval bring extra traffic and parked cars.

## Common security concerns in Bellerive

- Car theft and break-ins to cars
- Back doors and windows out of sight on sloping blocks
- Property damage

## Local tip: Protect the car at home and on event days

The Clarence division recorded 147 stolen vehicles and 134 motor vehicle burglaries last year. Lock the car every time, leave nothing on show, keep keys inside away from doors and windows, and use the garage if you have one. On event days at Bellerive Oval, park where there's lighting and people around, and take valuables with you.

**Before you hire: checklist**

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register ([abr.business.gov.au](http://abr.business.gov.au)).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
