

Caboolture Security Report

Local security guide - Caboolture QLD 4510 - Moreton Bay, northern greater Brisbane

About Caboolture

Caboolture is about 45 km north of the Brisbane CBD.

Caboolture is the main centre of the northern Moreton Bay region, with Caboolture Square, the King Street shops, Caboolture Hospital and a busy railway station, surrounded by growing housing estates and semi-rural blocks. The Queensland Police Service recorded 6,469 offences against the person and property in the Caboolture police division in 2025-26, close to the 6,386 of the year before. Theft was the largest category, with 1,683 other stealing offences and 701 shop thefts, followed by assault (891) and property damage (796).

Housing and local context

Housing stock: Low-set brick homes from the 1970s to the 1990s, newer estate homes, townhouses, and acreage and semi-rural blocks on the edges.

Caboolture's older streets have low-set brick homes built from the 1970s onwards, while new estates in and around the town have filled with modern brick homes, townhouses and duplexes. On the edges, acreage and semi-rural blocks bring long driveways, sheds and equipment stored away from the house. The town centre, hospital and station make the area a service hub for the northern Moreton Bay region.

Common security concerns in Caboolture

- Sheds, trailers and machinery on larger and semi-rural blocks
- Theft from shops and cars around the town centre
- Property damage to homes, cars and fences

Local tip: Protect the shed and machinery on bigger blocks

On Caboolture's larger and semi-rural blocks, sheds, trailers, quad bikes and machinery are often out of sight of both the house and the road. A locked gate at the driveway, a solar-powered camera or driveway alert on the approach, lighting on the shed and recorded serial numbers for equipment all help, and they give police something to work with if equipment does go missing.

Before you hire: checklist

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register (abr.business.gov.au).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
