Local security guide - Leanyer NT 0812 - Northern suburbs, City of Darwin

About Leanyer

Leanyer is about 16 km north-east of Darwin City.

Leanyer is a northern Darwin suburb near the coast, with the Leanyer Recreation Park water park, local shops and a mix of houses and units. At the 2021 Census, 4,597 people lived in Leanyer in about 1,574 occupied homes: 71% separate houses, 1% townhouses or semi-detached homes and 28% apartments, and 32% of homes were rented.

Housing and local context

Housing stock: Family homes from the 1980s onwards and blocks of units.

Leanyer has family homes from the 1980s onwards, many low-set with carports and tropical gardens, and blocks of units, with about 28% of homes being apartments or units at the 2021 Census. The water park and nearby coastal reserves draw visitors on weekends.

Common security concerns in Leanyer

- Cars under carports
- Keys near open windows
- Units with shared entries

Local tip: Cars, keys and carports

About 64% of Leanyer households had two or more cars at the 2021 Census. Keep keys inside and away from open windows and doors, lock every car, and cover the driveway and carport with a sensor light and a camera that records clearly at night.

Before you hire: checklist

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register (abr.business.gov.au).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
