Local security guide - Macquarie Fields NSW 2564 - South-west Sydney, City of Campbelltown

About Macquarie Fields

Macquarie Fields is about 38 km south-west of the Sydney CBD.

Macquarie Fields sits between Glenfield and Ingleburn in the City of Campbelltown, with the Georges River parklands to the east, a railway station and a mix of older public housing and newer private estates. BOCSAR recorded 1,058 criminal incidents in Macquarie Fields in the year to June 2026 (not counting transport fines and breaches of bail or court orders), up from 1,006 the year before. Intimidation, stalking and harassment (161), domestic violence-related assault (139) and malicious damage (111) were the largest groups, so much of the recorded crime happens between people who know each other rather than as break-ins.

Housing and local context

Housing stock: Townhouses and semi-detached homes from the former public housing estate, 1970s and 1980s brick houses, and newer homes in private estates.

Macquarie Fields grew from a large public housing estate built in the 1970s, where many homes are townhouses and semi-detached dwellings along shared pathways and courtyards, alongside streets of privately built brick homes and newer estates closer to the parklands. Shared footpaths and open car spaces mean many homes can be approached from several sides, so lighting and cameras need to cover more than the front door.

Common security concerns in Macquarie Fields

- Damage to and theft from cars in carports and on the street
- Homes on shared pathways that can be approached from several sides
- Harassment and intimidation, where a front-door camera can help record what happens

Local tip: Light up the carport

Many Macquarie Fields homes park cars in an open carport or on the street, where damage and theft from cars happen overnight. A sensor light and a camera with good night vision covering the carport and the street, and locking the car and taking valuables inside every night, deal with most of it. BOCSAR recorded 111 malicious damage offences and 67 thefts from motor vehicles here last year.

Before you hire: checklist

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register (abr.business.gov.au).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
