Local security guide - Redbank Plains QLD 4301 - Ipswich, City of Ipswich

About Redbank Plains

Redbank Plains is about 27 km south-west of the Brisbane CBD.

Redbank Plains is a young, fast-growing suburb in the City of Ipswich, between Goodna and Springfield, with local shopping centres and new estates filling the land south of the Ipswich Motorway. At the 2021 Census, 24,349 people lived in Redbank Plains in about 7,481 occupied homes: 85% separate houses, 13% townhouses or semi-detached homes and 2% apartments, and 58% of homes were rented.

Housing and local context

Housing stock: Low-set brick homes and new estate homes, duplexes and townhouses.

Redbank Plains is made up mostly of low-set brick homes built from the 1990s onwards and newer estate homes on smaller blocks, with duplexes and townhouses among them. Many homes are rented, and new estates are still being built, so some streets have building sites and vacant lots nearby.

Common security concerns in Redbank Plains

- Rented homes where changes need approval
- Building sites and vacant lots nearby
- Cars in driveways

Local tip: Renter-friendly security

Redbank Plains had a median age of 27 and 58% of homes rented at the 2021 Census. Renter-friendly security that needs no drilling, such as battery video doorbells, plug-in cameras and portable door locks, can move with you. Ask your agent for deadlocks and locking screens.

Before you hire: checklist

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is

current.

- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register (abr.business.gov.au).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
